Announcement to hold an additional programs of The Traditional Culture and Performing Arts Experience Program for Foreigners and its coverage.

As a new initiative this year, **Arts Council Tokyo (Tokyo Metropolitan Foundation for History and Culture)** holds accessible short programs that offer foreign visitors and others the opportunity to gain first-hand experience of traditional culture and performing arts around tourist attractions in Tokyo. In addition, we provide programs, which combine hands-on experience with the viewing of performances, as well as giving school children throughout Tokyo the opportunity to come into contact with Japanese traditional culture and performing arts, thereby enabling to deepen their understandings of the value of Japanese culture. 1. Programs for Foreign Visitors I
