Why not step into the boundless world of “GO”?

■ **What is “Go” ?** : “Go” is strategy board game that originated in China, spread to Japan and became popular among the aristocrats of the Heian period (794 – 1185). It developed independently from the Chinese game. “Go”, has been long-loved by the Japanese and appears in classical literature, such as *The Pillow Book* and *The Tale of Genji*.

Two players take turns placing a stone of their color ; black or white on the board, competing to see who captures more “territory” than the opponent. The rules are simple but “Go” is a profoundly deep game.
